

## **Call for Papers**

### **Research Workshop: Learning and Teaching Innovation & Impact in the Middle East**

Learning and teaching remains at the core heart of university. Learning and teaching include what individual academics of universities are doing to foster the nexus between learning and teaching and research. In this global competitive era, universities are continually developing or revising curricula to meet the market needs and labor market, and also ensure their students are exposed to cutting-edge research in their field of study. Learning and Teaching Innovation and Impact is perhaps an under-explored field of research in the Middle East. In the technological advances, for instance, Artificial Intelligence (AI), Blockchain, Big Data, and Data Analytics are playing a greater role in developing the curricula.

Submissions are invited which showcase innovations and best practice in learning and teaching at university and impact. Submissions for the calls should be original work on topics related to learning and teaching with a clear contextualization of Middle East settings. Proposed papers must not have been previously published in books or in periodicals. Research topics appropriate for the calls include, but are not limited to, the following themes:

- Learning and Teaching Pedagogy in the Middle East
- Factors influencing the development of curricula in the Middle East
- The impact of learning and teaching in the Middle East
- Innovation in Learning and Teaching Pedagogy in the Middle East
- Assurance of Learning Practices in the Middle East
- Quality Assurance Practices in the Middle East
- Local and International Accreditation Practices in the Middle East
- The role of the International Accreditation bodies in ensuring innovations in curricula

## Submission Guidelines

Submissions for the calls close on **30th October 2019**. Early submissions are welcome, and potential contributors are encouraged to contact the Research Committee to declare their interest and discuss ideas and topics. All proposals will be double blind-reviewed by at least two members of the advisory board for scope and quality.
