The Doctoral Faculty Commission (DFC) projected the demand and supply of doctoral faculty in business to 2012. These projections are based on the middle case of the Department of Education projections of degrees awarded and assumptions about business education under three different scenarios: Best Case, Status Quo, and Worst Case.
